Baklava

Layers of buttered filo, ground walnuts, sugar and cinnamon, covered in sweet honey syrup.

Kataifi

Shredded filo filled with chopped nuts and spices and baked to a golden brown; covered with honey syrup.

Finikia

Spiced cookie with a center of chopped walnuts, hint of orange, dipped in honey syrup and sprinkled with chopped nuts.
Delicious!

Kourambiethes

A favorite holiday cookie made with sweet butter and covered with powdered sugar to melt in your mouth!

Koulourakia

Twisted butter cookie. Delicious with coffee or tea!

Mini Baklava

A box of mini pieces of baklava.

Tsourekia (sweet bread)

Traditional Greek bread. Sweet yeast bread made with eggs, milk and butter.

Spanakopitakia

Frozen individual cheese rolls (1 dozen)-feta, cottage and parmesan cheeses wrapped in filo dough.

Frozen Spinach Pie (half pan)

Perfect side dish for any dinner party.

Spanakopita pan-Frozen spinach pie (half pan, 12 pieces cut in squares) – spinach, feta, cottage and parmesan cheeses layered in filo dough.
